

The official life span of UPVC is 35 years, and research shows that 95% of it can be recycled. Not only that but it can be recycled up to 10 times. This means UPVC can be reused, with minimal impact on the environment, for 350 years.


At Eurocell, we're committed to producing highquality products that reduce our impact on the environment. That's why we're at the forefront of sustainable developments in the UPVC industry.
